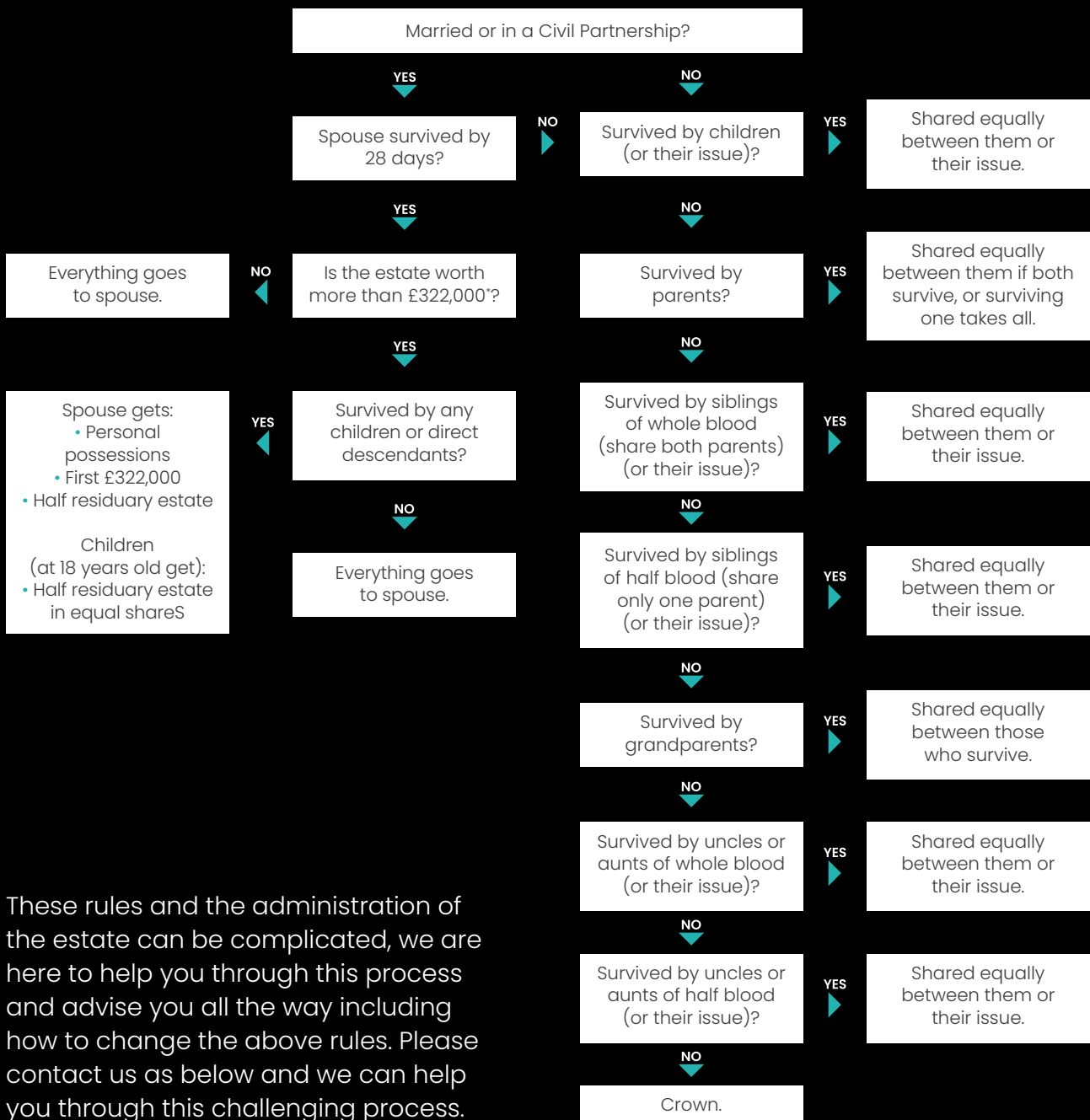




# CURRENT RULES OF INTESTACY

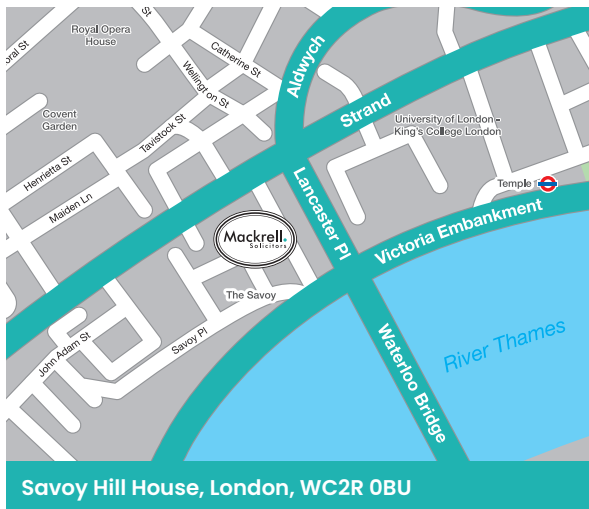
